

BREAK THE SILENCE

A lie that has often kept Christians silenced is that they are somehow **“not qualified”**. In this segment, Mark Greenwood shares from the Scriptures and from his life, the significance of being qualified by Jesus Christ and accepted in the beloved. Confident belief in this truth makes way for experiential intimacy with God, and this intimacy becomes the fuel for a Christ-like life.

Mark shares about the incredible harvest being won within the Indigenous Australian community, and how, through relationship with God and empowerment from the Holy Spirit, every Christian is called to this supernatural, intimacy-fueled, sharing of their faith.

Key Statement:

“Proper belief leads to proper behaviour”

Key Scriptures:

“Giving thanks to the Father, **who has qualified you** to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.” - Colossians 1:12

“Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God, who also made us **sufficient as ministers of the new covenant...**”
- 2 Corinthians 3:5-6

“He has made everything beautiful in its time. **Also He has put eternity in their hearts,** except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end.” - Ecclesiastes 3:11

“**And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God,** and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.” - John 17:3

“For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, **that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.**” - 2 Corinthians 5:21

HEALING MODULE

Heal the Sick **Mark 16:15-18**

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ACTIVATE

PERSONAL ACTIVATION - *For throughout the week*

This week ask God which person on your Oikos map you could reach out to and offer prayer for healing (or any other need).

ONE MINUTE WAIT

Write their name _____

GROUP ACTIVATION - *For NOW*

Head out into your local area to a location where people congregate (preferably the same place as last week). Break off into pairs if possible. It may help to pair people who are more confident with those who are not. Ideally pairing with the same gender unless married. Avoid being in groups larger than three, as it can be intimidating to those you approach.

Once paired, **find someone you can offer prayer for healing or for any other needs.** *Although this may sound a little daunting for some, we'd like to encourage each of you to step out.* Below are a few helpful examples of conversation starters:

Conversation Starters:

"Hi, this might sound a little strange, but we're currently doing a course in which we're learning about healing. You don't happen to have any pain or sickness in your body?"

"I'm part of a course where we've been seeing God heal people. Like (*insert example*). Did you have anything you needed prayer for tonight? Like any sickness or pain?"

If the person says no, you could say something like, "That's cool, so what are you folks doing today?" or share a testimony/ the gospel etc.

"Hi. I was wondering if you had anything you needed prayer for tonight?"

Steps to install the Silence Breakers App

Step 1) Open Safari
